NOTIFICATION OF UNDERGROUND WATER STORAGE TANKS LANGMAN RESERVE

November 2014

Dear property owner/resident

The Eastern Region Alliance (ERA) project known as “Waterproofing Eastern Adelaide” is intended to capture and make use of stormwater for irrigation purposes. The project is expected to reduce the cost of watering local reserves, green Adelaide’s eastern suburbs, and enhance the quality of water that is discharged to The Gulf.

Once water is captured and cleaned it will need to be stored for irrigation use during the drier months of the year. Langman Reserve has been selected as an appropriate site for storage. Two underground concrete tanks will be constructed at the northern end of the oval, with a small pumping shed located behind the tennis courts. Please see over page for site location.

The construction date is yet to be determined. Property owners and residents will be kept informed of the project’s progress through to completion. Access to sections of the reserve will be restricted during construction for safety reasons, but the area will be fully reinstated at completion and ultimately will not change how the reserve is currently used.

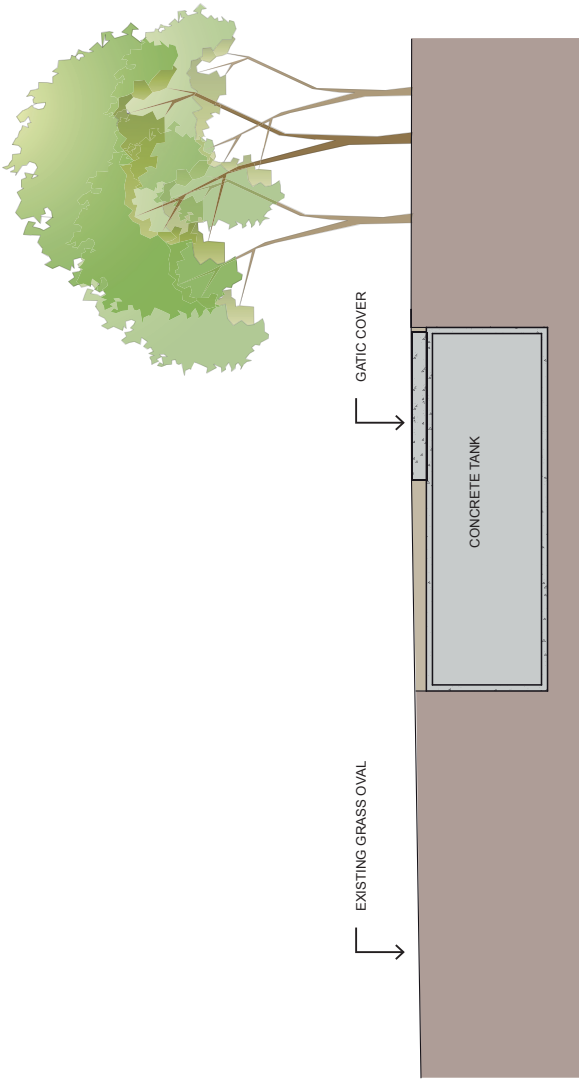


SITE PLAN
