Advance Notice of Infrastructure Works - Commencing November 2016 ERA Water: Waterproofing Eastern Adelaide Project

Waterproofing Eastern Adelaide is an important initiative being delivered by ERA Water, a subsidiary (entity) established by the Town of Walkerville (ToW), City of Norwood Payneham & St Peters (NPSP) and the City of Burnside (CoB). All three (3) Councils have been directly involved in the planning and delivery of this Project, which will provide environmental benefits for many years to come.

The Water Proofing Eastern Adelaide Project is supported through funding of \$9,500,000 (GST exclusive) from the Australian Government's National Urban Water and Desalination Plan and funding of \$2,000,000 (GST exclusive) from the Adelaide and Mount Lofty Ranges Natural Resources Management Board. The project involves the construction of an Aquifer Storage and Recovery (ASR) Scheme to harvest, treat, store and distribute recycled stormwater for the irrigation of parks, reserves and schools within the Eastern Region of Adelaide.

ERA Water has appointed a contractor to construct wetlands, bio filters and pump stations at Felixstow Reserve, which is part of the Waterproofing Eastern Adelaide Project and forms the first stage of the redevelopment at Felixstow Reserve.

Work on the Waterproofing Eastern Adelaide component of the redevelopment at Felixstow Reserve is scheduled to commence in November 2016 with the works anticipated to finish by April 2017. Once this stage of the works is completed, work will commence on redeveloping the remainder of Felixstow Reserve. Details relating to this component of the redevelopment will be made available to you closer to the commencement date.

During the construction stage, the construction site on Felixstow Reserve will be fenced off to maximise safety and reduce noise levels. Work hours will be in accordance with the Environment Protection Authority (EPA) legislation and guidelines. Please note that signage will be installed at Felixstow Reserve for the duration of the works with contact numbers for the Project info line in the event that you may have any issues.

Please note that local traffic management arrangements will also be in place throughout the duration of the works to ensure a safe work site. The Site Supervisor will coordinate access into and out of the work site. There will be two (2) entries into the construction site, through the car park off Langman Grove, near Wicks Avenue, and off Riverside Drive near the existing toilet block.

On behalf of ERA Water, I would like to apologise for any inconvenience that the proposed works may cause and ask for your patience whilst the works are carried out.
